Autumn Term Learning

Nursery will be focusing on two topics this autumn term. The first half will be **'What's my favourite?'** learning about our favourite things such as toys, places, foods and colours. The second half will be **'Can you sing a nursery rhyme?'** learning all about nursery rhymes.

Communication and language

We will be using circle time to discuss ourselves and our favourite things. Listening to songs, rhymes and stories and responding to them to enhance our understanding. We will sing a wide range of songs together and the children will select some of the rhymes themselves and vote for their favourite.

Personal, social and emotional development

We will be focusing on healthy eating and expressing our preferences. Then we will be learning about nursery rhymes and linking them to our own lives such as when Humpty Dumpty falls off the wall, thinking about questions such as: How do you think he feels? What do you do when you or someone else falls over? How can you help them?

Physical development

We will be thinking about ways of staying healthy and how we can incorporate exercise, sleep and healthy eating into our routine. We be focusing on developing our fundamental movement skills such as jumping, running, climbing and balancing.

Literacy

We will be sharing good quality key texts encouraging the children to develop an interest in books and helping them to understand and enjoy stories. The children will be learning about new words, ideas and concepts, especially those that broaden their understanding of the world and stimulate their imagination.

Mathematics

This term, our Maths learning will involve a range of activities focusing on matching and sorting and making comparisons between objects. Subitising up to 3 objects and reciting numbers past. Using shapes for building thinking about their properties e.g. flat sides for stacking

Understanding the world

We will be learning about the past linked to ourselves and our families and about changes that have happened throughout our lives. We will go on walks around our school grounds thinking about what we can see and hear. We will be discussing our favourite places and use different vocabulary to describe the places.

Expressive arts and design

We will explore colour mixing and take the opportunity to discuss our favourite colour and say why we like it? We will learn and sing a wide range of nursery rhymes and join in with actions.

Religious Education

We will be talking about harvest time thinking about why Christians say thank you to God at harvest time and talking about God being the creator.
