## **Autumn Term Learning**

Our first topic of the year is centred around the intriguing question 'Who am I?' Through various activities and discussions, we will encourage self-reflection, promote healthy habits, learn about different types of homes, and celebrate the diversity of families. Next half term we will look at, 'How do we celebrate?' In this term, our Reception class will be exploring the importance of various celebrations to different cultures and individuals.

# **Communication and language**

We will be providing the children with lots of opportunities to develop their communication and language skills including a focus on the use following instructions, turn taking and singing.

# Personal, social and emotional development

We will be looking at how we can become more independent. Children will also develop an understanding of how to stay healthy and build strong friendships.

#### Physical development

In PE, we will be learning different skills though books. The first two books are 'Elmer' and 'How to Catch a Star'. Children will learn how to travel in different ways, use their body to make shapes and start to learn to throw and catch.

# Literacy

We will be continuing our literacy work with Read Write Inc sessions as well as other reading and writing opportunities in continuous provision. There will be a focus on fine motor skills to help enable children to write using the correct form.

#### Mathematics

In mathematics, we will be looking at numbers to 5. We will be comparing groups and start to look at the number bonds to 5. We will also learn some shapes.

# **Understanding the world**

We will be learning about how there are similarities and differences in each family. Children will also link this with their environment and what is in their local area. We will then look at celebrations and what different religions and cultures celebrate around the world.

# Expressive arts and design

We will be using fruits and vegetables to create faces, and we will be exploring colours by colour mixing.

In RE, our units for the autumn term are harvest, I am special and Christmas.
