Autumn Term Learning

Below is an overview of the curriculum that will be covered in our first term.

English

We will continue to follow the Read Write Inc scheme to teach phonics. Children will recap the Set 1 and Set 2 sounds before learning the Set 3 sounds. We will enjoy a range of stories which we will base our writing on. Children will continue to work on their letter formation.

Maths

This autumn term, children will complete units on place value (within 10), addition and subtraction and shape. We will continue to support the children with their number formation.

Science

We will learn about the parts of the human body and explore the five senses. In the second half term, we will learn to identify and name everyday materials and explore their properties.

RF

Our RE units this term are 'Harvest' and 'Creation'. Children will learn the creation story as well as how to care of God's world.

History

Our unit is called, 'Childhood through time'. Children will write about their favourite toy today before moving on to look at toys which were popular when their parents and grandparents were children. We will also explore how birthdays were celebrated and how they are celebrated now.

Geography

In geography, we will learn about the seven continents and five oceans of the world using maps, globes and atlases.

Art and Design

Children will develop their drawing by completing exercises in their sketchbooks. We will experiment with different media to draw spirals, snail drawings and even take our drawing outside!

Design and Technology

In the second half term, children will design and make their own Christmas book front cover. The front cover will be a 2D mechanism and will have levers and sliders.

Music

We will listen and sing along to songs. Children will find and keep the pulse or beat by marching, clapping or swaying in time to music. They will play glockenspiels alongside songs.

PE

P.E. sessions are scheduled to take place on a Tuesday and a Thursday each week. This term, children will undertake units on gymnastics and developing the fundamental movement skills.

Computing

Children will become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. They will also create their own digital paintings.
