Spring Term Learning

Our first spring topic is based around the question, 'Who's afraid of the big, bad lion?' Children will learn about lions from Africa. They will explore African music linked to geography. Children will also discover what a silhouette is in art. In science, children will learn what animals eat and where they live. Next half term we will be looking at, 'Are plants alive?' We will explore where plants come from and what they need to grow successfully. Children will learn how to take care of plants through watering, sunlight exposure, and nurturing.

Communication and language

We will be providing the children with lots of opportunities to develop their communication and language skills including a focus on the use of questions, statements and back and forth conversations.

Personal, social and emotional development

We will be thinking about how we can keep ourselves safe and how sometimes we need an adult to help us. Then we will continue to think about our feelings in more depth.

Physical development

In PE, we will be thinking of different ways we can travel and then applying these skills when using apparatus. Children will also be continuing to learn their rolls and throwing skills.

Literacy

We will be continuing our literacy work with Read Write Inc sessions as well as other reading and writing in continuous provision. We will be encouraging children to use finger spaces and full stops too.

Mathematics

In mathematics, we will begin to look at the number bonds to 10. Children will then look at how to add and subtract. After that, we will look at patterns.

Understanding the world

We've got a busy term of developing understanding the world including knowing about habitats, similarities and differences between Garstang and Kenya, observing plants and how to look after their own plant.

Expressive arts and design

We will be using different prints to create our own animal. This will then be added to the children's sunset background that they will make using paint.

Religious Education

In RE, we are going to be listening to the stories that Jesus heard and told and then the Easter story.
